## **VISUAL STORY**



This is the outside of artsdepot. This is the main entrance. There are automatic sliding glass doors. When you walk through them, you will get to the Box Office.



This is the Box Office. This is where you can buy or pick up your tickets, find flyers for shows, or ask any questions you have about artsdepot. To go upstairs, you will turn left here and use the lift, the escalator, or the stairs.



These are the lifts. The lift on the left can take you to the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor or to the basement carpark. The lift on the right can only take you to the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.



These are the stairs and the escalator. They are on the ground floor with the Box Office. Both of them can take you to the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor. The landing at the top is close to the café.



This is where the lift takes you on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor. You can go left to the café, the Studio Theatre, and to get to the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> floors. There are male, female, disabled toilets and baby changing stations to the right. You can also go to playdepot on the right.



This is playdepot. It is a soft play area for children. It is on the right when you are walking out of the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor lifts. It can get noisy here during the day.



This is a gallery space on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor. It is on your left when you are walking from the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor lift to the café.



This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor. The café is at the back behind the white pillar. There are tables and chairs. You do not need to buy food or drinks to sit at the tables and chairs. It gets busy here with people before shows, and at lunchtime.



This is the entrance to the Studio Theatre. It is on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor near the tables and chairs for the café.



When you are going to a show in the Studio Theatre, there will be Visitor Service Assistants dressed in black stood by these wooden double doors. They will check your ticket, and you can ask them any questions you have about the building or the show.




This is inside the Studio Theatre. This is where you will sit to watch the show. The lights will be on when you sit down.



This is the lift to the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> floors. It is to the left of the café.



This is the café. The lift is on the left, and the stairs are on the right. You can buy hot and cold food, and hot and cold drinks. There is a water machine on the left where you can get water for free without asking.



These are the stairs to the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> floor. They will take you to the Pentland Theatre, the drama space, the art space, and the dance space.They are to the right of the café.



This is the landing on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor. This is the entrance to the Pentland Theatre stalls. There is one door on either side of the big long wooden bench. It looks the same on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor for the entrance to the Pentland Theatre circle.



When you are going to a show in the Pentland Theatre, there will be Visitor Service Assistants dressed in black stood by both wooden double doors. They will check your ticket, and you can ask them any questions you have about the building or the show.



This is inside the Pentland Theatre. The view is from the stage. The seats on the lower level are the stalls. The seats higher up are the circle. The lights will be on when you sit down in your seat.



This is the landing on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor.

These tables are opposite the Pentland Theatre stalls doors. You can sit at these tables and chairs if they're vacant.



This is bardepot on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor. This space is to the left of the Pentland Theatre stall doors if you're facing those doors. You can sit at the table and chairs if they are vacant. There are also higher table and chairs along the left. You can sit there too if they are vacant.
