

Young Artists Exhibition 2024

'artist' refers to an individual or artist collaboration (2 or more people working together).

Submission:

Each artist can submit up to **2** works. All applications are free to submit.

Ideally, the work would have been made over the last two years.

Closing date for submissions: Monday 13 May, 12pm

You must include with your submission:

- **Images of the submission (maximum of 2)**

All images sent by email as jpeg files up to 3MB in size. Alternatively, printed copies of images/photographs may be posted to us. Write your name and the title of the artwork(s) on the back of any printed images. Please do not send the original artwork.

For audio-visual/digital works please submit an extract or sample up to 5 minutes via an online link on the submission form or WeTransfer invitation.

All written material should be sent by email in a word document or pdf, or by post as printed documents.

Shortlisting:

A panel of Youth Advocates and art professionals will shortlist the work for the exhibition. The selection panel's decision is final.

Artists will be notified whether they have been accepted into the exhibition by Friday 17 May. Please note that we are unable to give feedback.

Successful:

The exhibition will take place in artsdepot's Apthorp Gallery and will be curated by artsdepot staff.

If your submission is successful, **you are responsible** for transporting artworks to and from artsdepot on the following dates:

Delivery of artworks to artsdepot:

- Mon 20 May, 10am - 4pm
- Tue 21 May, 10am - 4pm
- Wed 22 May, 10am - 4pm
- Thu 23 May, 10am - 4pm

Collection of artworks from artsdepot:

- Tue 3 June, 10am – 4pm
- Wed 4 June 10am – 4pm
- Thu 5 June 10am – 4pm
- Fri 6 June 10am – 4pm
- Sat 7 June 10am – 4pm

artsdepot does not supply any form of transportation for artworks to or from the venue. Please note, if your audio-visual/digital submission is successful, the work must be provided in CD/DVD format for the exhibition by the artist.

Usage & Sales:

If selected for the exhibition, the artist agrees to the reproduction of images of their work (at no fee) in association with the exhibition and future artsdepot exhibitions (including publicity, press, website and catalogue).

artsdepot will not be able to sell work as part of the exhibition.

artsdepot Young Artists Exhibition will be open to the public between Sunday 26 May – Saturday 1 June 2024, 10am - 4pm.

All work will remain in situ until the collection dates mentioned above.

Other:

The Aphorp Gallery is an invigilated space and is only open when a volunteer is present. This is for insurance purposes and to ensure the security of the works displayed.
