The Brief

artsdepot will celebrate its 21st Birthday in October 2025 and has embarked upon an ambitious heritage project, supported by the National Heritage Lottery Fund. As part of this project, we are offering a £3,000 visual art commission for the creation of a colourful freestanding installation or sculpture to celebrate artsdepot's birthday, heritage and work in Barnet during an eventful 20 years! The new commission will be unveiled as part of our 20th birthday celebration, alongside a heritage exhibition.


The 20th anniversary project focuses on artsdepot's conception and building during a time of transition and how people have contributed to making the organisation what it is. Archive materials will be available for the artist to consult and they will work with volunteers and artsdepot staff to develop the piece.

Keeping in mind artsdepot's commitment to sustainability, we are looking for a piece that uses repurposed materials that captures the spirit of the venue as a creative home for everyone. The piece will be displayed in our foyer and be the first thing that visitors see on arrival, so will be a main focus of the exhibition.

We are seeking an established, professional, visual artist, with experience working in a community context.

The piece will be in place for 8 months so should be safe and durable for the length of the display. At the end of the exhibition the piece will join artsdepot's archive.

The piece will be displayed in an area measuring: Width 6.5m (usable space may vary)
Height 5.0m – 6.5m
Depth 3.16m

Delivery of the project will take place in July – August with installation the first week of September 2025.

- Collaborate with artsdepot, the Heritage Consultant and volunteers, (to plan and create an inspirational installation for the venue.
- Review selected research and donated/lent materials and build connections and knowledge about the communities and history of North Finchley.
- Create a new artwork in dialogue with artsdepot's CEO / Creative Director that will be presented within our 20th Anniversary exhibition.

- Feed into project evaluation and attend the launch of artsdepot's heritage exhibition on Thursday 11 September 2025.
- Ensure all work is carried out within required Health and Safety legislation

- Demonstrable and proven track record of successfully completing visual art commissions based on a range of source material
- At least 3 years' experience working as a professional visual artist
- Ability to prioritise and work under pressure with good time management and organisational expertise
- Energetic, creative team player with a high level of enthusiasm
- Willingness to work flexibly and in particular be available for client contact which will require some evening and weekend work.

- Experience of working with multiple partners and ability to work diplomatically with a wide range of people
