

Young Artists Exhibition 2026: Light + Flight

Terms and Conditions

'artist' refers to an individual or artist collaboration (2 or more people working together).

Submission:

Each artist can submit up to **2** works. All applications are free to submit.

Ideally, the work would have been made over the last two years.

Closing date for submissions: Friday 24th April, 12pm.

You must include with your submission:

- **Images of the submission (maximum of 2)**

All images must be uploaded in jpeg files up to 128 MB in size via the online submission form on the [artsdepot website](http://artsdepot.co.uk). Alternatively, printed copies of images/photographs may be posted to us. Write your name and the title of the artwork(s) on the back of any printed images. Please do not send the original artwork.

For audio-visual/digital works please send an extract or sample up to 5 minutes via WeTransfer directly to gallery@artsdepot.co.uk.

Please note: The short statement you submit about your work will be included in the exhibition catalogue.

Shortlisting:

A panel of art professionals will shortlist the work for the exhibition. The selection panel's decision is final.

Artists will be notified whether they have been accepted into the exhibition by Tuesday 5th May. Please note that we are unable to give feedback.

Successful:

The exhibition will take place in the artsdepot's Apthorp Gallery and will be curated by artsdepot staff.

If your submission is successful, **you are responsible** for transporting artworks to and from artsdepot on the following dates:

Delivery of artworks to artsdepot (10am - 4pm):

- Sat 9 May
- Sun 10 May
- Mon 11 May
- Tue 12 May
- Wed 13 May

Collection of artworks from artsdepot (10am - 4pm):

- Wed 3 June
- Thu 4 June
- Fri 5 June
- Sat 6 June
- Sun 7 June

artsdepot does not supply any form of transportation for artworks to or from the venue. Please note, if your audio-visual/digital submission is successful, the work must be provided in CD/DVD format for the exhibition by the artist.

Usage & Sales:

If selected for the exhibition, the artist agrees to the reproduction of images of their work (at no fee) in association with the exhibition and future artsdepot exhibitions (including publicity, press, website and catalogue).

artsdepot will not be able to sell work as part of the exhibition.

artsdepot YA Exhibition will be open to the public between Sunday 24 May - Saturday 30 May 2026, 10am-4pm.

All work will remain in situ until the collection dates mentioned above.

Other:

The Apthorp Gallery is an invigilated space and is only open when a volunteer is present. This is for insurance purposes and to ensure the security of the works displayed.
